Summer Fun starts at Sunnybrook

Sunnybrook Montessori Summer Program offers an opportunity to continue Montessori based curriculum in a challenging learning environment as well as an opportunity of the Basic Camp Program with various themes in unique and exciting ways! Summer staff use daily lessons, arts and crafts, science projects, field trips (when age appropriate) and more to explore exciting themes. Individual and group projects will be encouraged. Special guests related to our unit studies visit Sunnybrook children for fun and entertainment. Our Summer Program includes ample “free” time for children to engage in social activities and imaginative play. Music is included in the daily routine. Activities are offered based on developmental needs and age appropriateness. Schedules vary from class to class.

MONTESSORI CLASS (6/21-7/2, 7/6-7/16, 7/19-7/30, 8/2-8/13, 8/16-8/27)
This class offers all year around Montessori Program with rich academic curriculum. All sessions are based on summer related themes and activities. It's a great opportunity for the new students to be exposed to the Montessori environment before the school year starts and for easy transitioning. Minimum of 10 students enrolled in each session are required.

SPECIALTY CAMPS

Gardening: June 21-July 2 (10 days)
Children will study the nature of a variety of plants and their structure from small flower to giant trees and will discover all possible tips and techniques how to grow plants and maintain a Garden. They will also learn how to use and handle real gardening tools.

Yoga and Nutrition: July 6-16 (9 days)
Yoga/ Nutrition Camp is designed to teach children good food choices. The goal is to educate children why eat fresh food and why eat sweets sparingly and help them to gain some healthy habits. By using simple tools children will be encouraged to prepare tasty healthy snacks. Daily Yoga: stretching out, learning to breathe, balancing and more will be a part of everyday activities.

Art/Crafts: July 19-30 (10 days) This amazing camp will build a foundation for art appreciation from the youngest child to the oldest. We will start looking at proportion, light, and perspective. Children will learn about different styles of artists and their art works and will create their own art pieces.

Culinary Art: Aug.2-13 (10 days)
Ten days of endless opportunities to be exposed to Culinary Art and to express your passion and creativity in the kitchen. With hands-on experience children will practice handling food safely, using cooking utensils, learning techniques to prepare and design snacks, salads and dessert. They will make a recipe book to take home at the end of the Session to share with friends.

Science: Aug. 16-27 (10 days)
Earth Science and Conservation Camp children will learn all about Planet Earth: Size, Orbit, Axis, Tilt, Season, Why the Sky is blue and How we should care for our Earth including Conservation and Recycling. This Session includes also study of Geology: what's inside the Earth, different types of rocks, Volcanoes, and how Rivers can change the face of the Earth.

Transportation: June 21-July 2 (10 days) Let's pack up our things to travel around the World to experience the privilege of all kinds of Transportation on Land and Water. We will find out about many occupations associated with them and participate in variety of planned activities and fun dramatic games.
